Worcester, ss:

To any Constable of the Town of Auburn, County of Worcester, Greetings:

Pursuant to the Provisions of Chapter 585 of the Acts of 1947, entitled “An Act of Establishing the Auburn Water District in the Town of Auburn,” you are hereby required to notify and warn the qualified legal voters within the water district, such district being described in the act as the entire town of Auburn, except that portion of said town now comprising the Elm Hill Water District, so-called, to meet at the Auburn Water District Office, with elections beginning at 4:00 P.M. on Monday, May 11th, 2026, for the Annual Meeting of the District to act on the following articles:

ARTICLE 1: ELECTION

To elect by ballot between the hours of 4:00 and 6:00 p.m. the following officer(s):
One (1) Commissioner for a Three (3)-year term.

And to meet immediately after the elections at approximately 6:05 P.M., to act on the following articles:

ARTICLE 2: APPOINTMENTS

To appoint, as needed, a Treasurer and/or Clerk.

ARTICLE 3: REPORTS

To hear reports of the District Commissioners and District Treasurer, and act thereon.

ARTICLE 4: ANNUAL BUDGET

To see if the District will vote to raise and appropriate or transfer from available funds a sum of money for maintenance and operation, administrative expense, debt expense and capital expenses, or take any action thereon.

ARTICLE 5: BORROWING

To see if the District will vote to authorize the Treasurer, with the approval of the Commissioners, to borrow in anticipation of revenue for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2026 in accordance with the provisions of General Laws, Chapter 44, Section 4, and to renew any note or notes with the provisions of General Laws, Chapter 44, Section 17 or act thereon.

ARTICLE 6: PFAS REMOVAL TREATMENT PLANT

To see if the District will vote to raise and appropriate borrow or transfer from available funds a sum for the Church Street Wells PFAS Removal Water Treatment Plant, which was included in the Massachusetts 2026 Drinking Water State Revolving Fund Final Intended Use Plan, including the payment of costs incidental or related

thereto; and to determine whether this appropriation shall be raised by borrowing with the potential of borrowing from the Massachusetts Clean Water Trust or otherwise; or take any action thereon.

ARTICLE 7: CHURCH STREET GARAGE

To see if the District will vote to raise and appropriate borrow or transfer from available funds for the design and public bidding of the construction of a garage building at 75 Church Street including the payment of costs incidental or related thereto; and to determine whether this appropriation shall be raised by transfer from available funds, borrowing or otherwise, or to take any other action relative thereto.

ARTICLE 8: MILLING & PAVING

To see if the District will vote to transfer from available funds for the milling and paving of Southbridge Street from the Worcester line to Sword Street associated with the water main interconnection project and the reconstruction and paving of the front parking lot of the District Office, including the payment of costs incidental or related thereto; or to take any other action relative thereto.

ARTICLE 9: CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS

To see if the District will vote to transfer a sum a money for Capital Improvements, including the cleaning of District water supply wells and the Church Street PFAS pilot study, including the payment of costs incidental or related thereto; or to take any other action relative thereto.

And you are hereby directed to serve this warrant by posting attested copies thereof in at least five public places with the District, seven days, at least, before the time said of the Annual District Meeting.

Hereof fail not, and make due return of the warrant to the Water Commissioners of said District this the twenty third day of April 2026.
