
To any Constable of the Town of Auburn, County of Worcester, Greetings:

Pursuant to the Provisions of Chapter 585 of the Acts of 1947, entitled "An Act of Establishing the Auburn Water District in the Town of Auburn," you are hereby required to notify and warn the qualified legal voters within the water district, such district being described in the act as the entire town of Auburn, except those portions of said town now comprising the Elm Hill District, so-called, to meet in the Auburn Water District at approximately 9:00 A.M. on Wednesday, June 29th 2022 to act on the following articles:

ARTICLE 1 To see if the District will vote to appropriate a sum of money from free cash for the Stabilization Fund, or to take any other action relative thereto

And you are hereby directed to serve this warrant by posting attested copies thereof in at least five public places within the District, fourteen days, at least, before the time said of the Special District Meeting.

Hereof fail not, and make due return of the warrant to the Water Commissioners of said District, this the fourteenth day of June 2022.
